The Minister General, with his Definitory, made the following appointments and established the following:



On April 5, 2017, Friar Valentín REDONDO, from the Province of Our Lady of Montserrat, Spain, was confirmed for a second four-year term as the guardian of the General Friary of St. Massimiliano Kolbe, in Rome.



On April 8, 2017, Friar Franklin DURAN ZAMBRANO from the Provincial Custody of Our Lady of Coromoto, Venezuela, began service as the new guardian of the General Friary of St. Anthony at the Baths (Vigna), in Rome. He replaces Friar Timothy KULBICKI.



On April 24, 2017, Friar Francesco CELESTINO, from the Provincial Custody of St. Daniel and Companion Martyrs, Calabria, Italy, began service as the guardian of the General Friary of the Twelve Holy Apostles, in Rome. He replaces Friar Roberto BRANDINELLI who was appointed Vicar Provincial of the Italian Province of St. Anthony of Padua. The General Definitory extends its best wishes to Friars Franklin, Valentín and Francesco and assures them of its prayers. Heartfelt thanks go to Friars Timothy and Roberto from both the General Definitory and the friars of the communities they so generously and wisely served for four years.

Vatican: Pope Meets with Franciscan Ministers General



On April 10, 2017, Pope Francis met with the four Ministers General of the Franciscan First Order: Friar Marco TASCA, OFM Conv.; Friar Michael PERRY, OFM; Friar Mauro JOHRI, OFM Cap.; and Friar Nicholas POLICHNOWSKI, TOR.

During the meeting, the Ministers General presented the Holy Father with information on the planned Franciscan University construction project, the interobediential community in the Holy Land, and the common and fraternal initiatives planned for commemorating the anniversary of both the Bull Ite vos and St. Francis' visit to the Sultan Malik al-Kamil in Damietta (Egypt).

At the same time, they presented the Pope with a request that they be allowed to entrust friars who are not priests with roles in community leadership (guardian, Custos, and Minister Provincial).

Finally, they asked Pope Francis to grant a special audience to all the friars who will go to Rome on the anniversary of the approval of our Rule, November 29, 2017.

- Received a petition from Friar Joseph Martin Hoang for admission to Solemn Profession. After a review
 of his Directors' recommendations and of a report by Br. James Reiter regarding his scrutinium, this
 petition was favorably voted upon. Congratulations, Friar Joseph Martin!
- Both the celebration of Solemn Profession and the First Professions in the Province will be August 2, 2017, at 7 PM, at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish.
- Received and regretfully accepted the resignation of Friar Giles Zakowicz (Our Lady of the Angels Province) as Novice Master and Guardian of St. Francis Novitiate and Friary. Friar Giles is thanked for many years of service to the Federation and the Novices, and for his tremendous hospitality to all.
- Upon the recommendation of the Conventual Franciscan Federation (CFF), elected Friar Joseph Wood (St. Bonaventure Province) as both Novice Master and Guardian of St. Francis Novitiate and Friary.
- Voted to allow the expenditure of no more than \$40,000 in order to do an evaluation and feasibility study to be done for the St. Joseph Cupertino Friary, in Castro Valley.
- Voted to call an Extraordinary Provincial Chapter to occur beginning at 9 AM, Tuesday, June 26th, at our Community Week, in order to consider the sale of the Bello house in Pismo Beach.
- Decided that other areas to be treated at Community Week would be:
 - Creation of a first draft of a Strategic Plan
 - A reworking and updating of the 2005 Province Statutes.
 - Introduction of the work of creating a Province "Philosophy of Aging," which document was recommended by our Visioning Committee.
 - ^o A discussion of the work of our Delegation and Mission Promotion.
- Discussed a number of personnel issues and opportunities.
- Discussed the meeting of Friars Tom Czeck, Joseph Kim, James Reiter and Victor Abegg with the Viva Francis Foundation, in order to explore how we might grow support and membership in the Foundation.
- Decided that John will attempt to do the Provincial Visitation during his visit to the Delegation in August, and for the Province in the month of October, 2017.
- Received a financial report from Friar George Cherrie for the months of January and February, indicating that, as of the close of the first two months, the Province had a net loss of \$9,679.
- Received a Balance Sheet as of the closing of February 28, 2017. After adjusting for the Mission Fund, this shows that the net Province Cash Assets are at \$1,056,658.
- Reviewed the Balance sheet as of June 30, 2014, showing the net Province Cash Assets at \$1,167,798.
 Comparing these two Balance sheets indicates that, between June 30, 2014, and February 28, 2017, the Province incurred a net loss of \$111,140.

- Financial reports are now being posted on the Friars only section of the website.
- Voted to allow the Delegation of Vietnam to expend an additional \$10,000 in order to purchase property that is adjacent to the Annunciation Friary in Cu Chi.
- Decided to postpone the emergency actions required by our Financial Crisis plan pending further updates.
- The next Definitory will be held on June 25, 2017, at 5 PM.
