- Met with our Province Treasurer Br. George Cherrie and discussed various issues
 - Reviewed the most recent Financial reports of the Province
 - Discussed the progress of our bookkeeper Marie Exberger and the new bookkeeping system.
 - Discussed the timing of our Provincial budgeting for 2018 and decided upon a Friary budget due date of October 23, 2017 in order that we could review them at the next Definitory.
 - Discussed a change in policy for retirement income and subsidies for 2018. We will begin directing all incomes from our Social Security/Disability account and all Friarys into a separate Retirement account. In addition, each Friary will receive a monthly subsidy for each retired/infirm Friar.

- Reviewed and approved for another year our Memorandum of Understanding with the Philippine Delegation for our Delegation Novices to attend there.
- After consultation with Friar Jude Winkler and the General Curia, decided upon having two separate election Committees for our next Provincial elections. The Delegation Committee will distribute, collect and tabulate ballots, then communicate to the Province Committee who will have done the same. The Province Committee will then publish the results.
- Elected Friars to serve on the respective election Committees:

- Discussed several personnel opportunities and situations.
- Received an update on the health care consultation for all Friars of the Province by Christian Brothers from John Heinz
